

The study visits will show the smart implementations on the **Urumea Riverside District**, a smart and sustainable district in San Sebastian lighthouse city. This visit will be an excellent opportunity to share knowledge and experiences with different city experts from the areas of energy efficiency, sustainable mobility and ICTs/Infrastructures of Replicate project.

The Urumea Riverside District is composed by a residential, industrial and a green area and will be reached by **electric buses** that connect the city center with this smart district. These e-buses represent one of the most demanding and challenging experiences nowadays.

The **Txomin residential neighborhood** will be visited were the first urban **District Heating** of this size in the Basque Country is already in operation. The DH owned by Fomento San Sebastian and managed through a public-private inno vative model, will give service to more than 1.500 new homes and 156 retrofitted ones.

The industrial park **Polígono 27** is an example of smart ICT and infrastructures deployment and has a unique sustainable building **Enertic**, where experiences on smart implementations, difficulties, challenges and results will be **shared**.










